

<p>Definition of a "Grade A" egg (exterior grade)</p>	<p>Must be clean, with no dirt or foreign material. Must be the usual shape, and have little to no rough areas or calcium deposits (must be smaller than 1/8 of an inch). May have slight ridges which do not affect shape or strength. Must be free of thin spots and body checks.</p>
<p>How many breeds of turkey are there?</p>	<p>One. The Turkey.</p>
<p>How many classes of Geese are there? Name them.</p>	<p>There are three classes. Light, Medium, and Heavy.</p>
<p>How many days does it take for a Muscovy egg to hatch?</p>	<p>35 days (but can be anywhere from 33-37 days)</p>
<p>How many days does it take for a pigeon egg to hatch?</p>	<p>18 days (but can be anywhere from 17-19 days)</p>
<p>What is a breed characteristic?</p>	<p>A characteristic that is specific to that breed. Example: Shape and Size of the bird.</p>
<p>What is the definition of sex linked?</p>	<p>They are a cross bred chicken. Upon hatching, you can determine their gender based on the color or pattern of the chick.</p>
<p>What is the name of the department that sets the guidelines for grading eggs?</p>	<p>The USDA. United States Department of Agriculture.</p>
<p>What is the origin of the American Fantail?</p>	<p>The breed is thought to have originated in India, China, or Spain</p>
<p>When were Modern Game Bantams accepted into the Standard of Perfection?</p>	<p>1874</p>
